Growing up in Bridgewater, NH along the banks of the Pemigewasset River, Glen Lucas knew from a young age that he wanted a career that would revolve around his love for outdoor activities. His career path was set in motion through "ride-alongs" with his longtime idol and current mentor Lt. James Kneeland. Upon graduating from Unity College with a degree in Conservation Law Enforcement, Glen began his career at NH Fish and Games. Little did he know what this career was going to bring him! Throughout his 11-year career, Glen has been an invaluable member of several of NHFG teams – Advanced Search and Rescue, Dive Team, Airboat Team and a Field Training Officer. In 2017, the reality television series *North Woods Law* began filming in northern New Hampshire. The series has followed Glen and other officers in their many adventures, from stray bears at dumpsters, to chasing poachers. In February 2015, Glen was part of a rescue attempt of a lost hiker attempting to complete the Presidential Traverse in the White Mountains. This harrowing attempt is documented in the book *Where You'll Find Me*. You are invited to hear Glen tell what it is really like to be a "reality star" and how that fateful day in the White Mountains has changed his perspective on life.
