- Legislation Update (Carl)
  - o HB 0538 New bill requires any licensee applying for licensure through comity is deemed granted until board can act on it (for 120 days)
    - 1. Bill is not specific (lumps engineers with other professions like barbers, aestheticians, etc. Occupational with professional)
    - 2. NHSPE submitted letter in opposition to bill
    - 3. Carl coordinated with Art Schwartz prior to sending letter
    - 4. Model law allows joint board to issue temporary license, but this bill requires it

- o Several organizations have not paid dues
- House delegates webinar
  - o Discussion about membership dues and consolidating to one platform
